TAX PREPARERS

Learn to prepare basic tax returns with 30 hours of free training over four classes on Saturday, December 28th and January 4th, Sunday, January 12th, and Saturday, January 18th.

INTAKE ASSISTANTS AND INTERPRETERS

Assist taxpayers with their IRS and agency intake forms or with interpreting needs with one three-hour training offered on multiple dates throughout January.
